MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 10th DECEMBER 2018

Present: Cllr Gray, Cllr Brown, Cllr Fisher, Cllr K Watkins and Cllr I Watkins.

Apologies: None received.

In Attendance: Cllr Greenhalgh and Cllr Cannings and 1 member of the public.

Police Report:

Cllr Gray advised that 3 crimes had been reported in October, 1 x burglary, 1 x criminal damage/arson on School Lane and 1 x vehicle crime on Holme Hall Lane. The total number of crimes for the year is 10. Cllr Greenhalgh advised that Ward Councillors now receive a weekly Police report, which can be forwarded to the Parish Council, a meeting had also been held with the Police Commissioner and concerns had been raised with regards to the data inaccuracies on the Police reporting system.

Public Forum:

Mrs Gray advised that a bramble bush on Holme Hall Lane located close to the bus stop requires cutting back. \there is an issue with moss on the footpaths along Raw Lane and Holme Hall Lane, there is red and white tape in the bushes near the roundabout that requires removing. There is an issue with lorries not giving way to oncoming vehicles when exiting the quarries, the lorries are also speeding through the village and damaging the grass verges.

Cllr Gray welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Cllr Brown advised that she had attended a presentation regarding Economics at Doncaster Sheffield Airport, Cllr Gray advised that he had been unable to attend the District Commanders meeting. Paint has been sourced for the telephone box (cost of £20.00). Cllr Gray had attended both remembrance services held at the Church and had purchased a wreath for each service.

113/2018 Ward Councillor Report

Cllr Greenhalgh and Cannings attended the meeting and provided the Council with a list of local law firms who provide a 30-minute free consultation. A meeting had taken place with Kyle Heydon (DMBC) and Cllr Gray to review the concerns with the Maltby development drainage plans.

114/2018 Planning Applications

3 School Lane: Erection of single storey side and rear extension, front entrance porch and bay window: Council resolved to raise concerns with the close proximity of the gas canisters and the neighbouring property.

Low Farm, Lime Kiln Lane: Consent, agreement or approval required by conditions 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 of planning application 17/02546/FUL: No objections.

Wilsic Hall School: Consent to Crown raise to 5m and selectively reduce branches overhanging gardens and oil tanks. The trees are subject to W4 of Doncaster Borough Council Tree Preservation Order (No.213) 1998
Wilsic Hall: No objections.

Cllr K Watkins reported a large pothole on Lime Kiln Lane, Cllr Gray advised of potholes on Stainton Lane, Clerk to report to DMBC. Cllr Gray advised that new signs had been installed on Stainton Lane.
