MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 28th JANUARY 2019

Present: Cllr Gray, Cllr Brown, Cllr K Watkins and Cllr I Watkins.

Police Report:

Cllr Gray advised that there hadn't been any crimes reported in November.

Public Forum:

Mrs Gray advised that the drain adjacent to the roundabout on Stainton Lane/Scotch Spring Lane is full of mud. This is causing excess water on the road which is hazardous when frozen.

Cllr Gray welcomed everyone to the meeting and advised the Council that Cllr Fisher had resigned from his position.

03/2019 Ward Councillor Report

Cllr Cannings attended the meeting to advise that Cllr Greenhalgh could not attend due to having to attend another meeting. Positive feedback has been received from the drainage engineer at DMBC who is reviewing the drainage plans of the proposed development at Maltby, concerns regarding the affect to Ruddle Dyke have been sent to RMBC. Ruddle Dyke has been surveyed, questionnaires will be sent to the residents residing adjacent to the dyke to receive feedback, further modelling will be implemented if the dyke is used for drainage from the proposed development. DMBC have are also working towards improving the drainage along Holme Hall Lane to reduce the issues with run off water.

04/2019 Planning Applications

17 School Lane: Cllr Gray advised that the property is being extended, a planning enquiry was made by the owner who were advised by DMBC that planning permission is not required for the work, However, residents have raised concerns with the size of the extension, DMBC have been informed and will check the development within the next 3 to 4 weeks.

05/2019 Highways and Footpaths

Cllr Gray requested that the Clerk report the grates on Stainton Lane/ Scotch Spring Lane that are clogged with mud.
