MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 7TH OCTOBER 2019

Police Report:

Cllr Gray advised that 2 crimes had occurred in August, 1 x vehicle crime on Holme Hall Lane and another theft from Little Wood.

Chairman's opening remarks and Declarations of Interest

Cllr Gray welcomed everyone to the meeting.

94/2019 Co-option of new Councillor

Cllr Gray advised that Mr Calton had applied for the vacancy of Councillor, Council agreed to the co-option of Mr Calton.

95/2019 Signing of acceptance of office form by new Councillor

Mr Calton signed the acceptance of office form.

96/2019 Minutes of the last meeting held on Monday 2nd September 2019

Council noted a spelling mistake on the public forum item, once amended the minutes were recorded as a true record and signed by Cllr Gray.

97/2019 Matters arising from the minutes.

98/2019 Ward Councillor Report

Cllr Cannings attended the meeting to advise that funding is available from Doncaster Sheffield Airport for local communities. The drainage department at DMBC are reviewing the plans for the proposed housing estate at Grange Lane Maltby.

99/2019 Planning Applications

Land at Grange Lane Maltby: Cllr Gray advised that the plans for the development had been amended but the drainage systems had not been altered. Cllr Gray advised that an objection had been submitted to RMBC raising concerns towards the risk of Ruddley Dyke flooding.

19/02129/COND Consent, agreement or approval required by conditions 7 and 23 of planning application 16/01220/REVA Holme Hall Quarry Holme Hall Lane: Cllr Gray advised that the application related to the monitoring of noise, 6 monitoring stations are to be used. Condition 23 relates to archaeological surveys to take place before works commence. No objections raised from Council members.

Consultation on proposed reforms to permitted development rights to support the deployment of 5G and extend mobile coverage: Cllr Gray advised planning laws regarding mobile antennae are changing, YLCA have requested feedback from Parish Councils, Cllr Gray volunteered to complete the survey on behalf of Stainton Parish Council.

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100/2019 Highways and Footpaths

Cllr I Watkins reported an issue with moss on the footpath along Raw Lane, Cllr Brown advised of a pothole on Stainton Lane, Cllr Gray advised that DMBC are carrying out significant road repairs in the area. Cllr Gray reported an issue with a speeding vehicle travelling along Raw Lane, concerns were raised regarding the location of the 30mph speed warning sign. Cllr Calton advised of speeding issue on Holme Hall Lane. Cllr Gray advised that the Council had previously requested a one-way system. Clerk to raise the concerns with the highways department at DMBC.

101/2019 Defibrillator

102/2019 Village Hall Matters

Cllr Brown advised that tickets are available for the Male Voice Choir event on the 22nd November and Wreath Making in December. Cllr Gray reported an issue with the guttering on the left-hand side wall and several slates on the roof have been lifted by moss.

Cllr K Watkins advised that she had attended a site meeting with Max Walker from Wicksteed to review the play facilities, a plan and cost for the project is expected in the next few weeks. Cllr Gray advised that he had met with Simone Garton from DMBC to discuss the project, DMBC can provide a feasibility study for a cost of £618.00.

104/2019 Telephone Box

Cllr Gray advised that Stephen Racjan from DMBC had emailed South Yorkshire Probation Service to see if they could assist with the work but had not received a reply. Cllr Brown suggested contacting the Youth Offender team in Sheffield.

Cllr Gray advised that the Flag Iris had been treated on 12th of September. Council agreed for the grounds maintenance team to carry out one more session around the pond before winter.
