MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL PARISH MEETING HELD ON 14TH MAY 2018

Present: Cllr Gray, Cllr Brown, Cllr Fisher, Cllr I Watkins, Cllr K Watkins and Clerk Sarah Youngman.

In Attendance: None present.

1. **Apologies for Absence:** None received.
2. **Minutes of the meeting held on 15th May 2017:** Signed and approved.
3. **Matters arising from the minutes:** Cllr Gray advised that a bus service had been re-instated within the past few months which will benefit the residents of the village. Speeding traffic continues to be an issue and has been raised with DMBC and South Yorkshire Police, the feedback received was that no actions will be taken to reduce the speed limit around the village or to install extra signage. Cllr Fisher advised that the lighting on Holme Hall Lane is still an issue. Cllr Gray advised that the Council plan to improve the play facilities on the recreation field and although the broadband issue had not been resolved it is expected to be complete within the next few months. Cllr I Watkins questioned whether the plans for the north side of the Hargreaves site are being amended as there is no planning permission in place; Cllr Gray advised that he is unsure of the situation with the plans for the site.
4. **To consider any matters which affect the Police and Community:** Cllr Gray advised that a new Police District Commander has been appointed and Parish Councils have been invited to attend an introductory meeting with the Commander in July. Cllr Fisher advised of ongoing issues with quad bikes in the area; Cllr I Watkins advised that all incidents need to be reported to the Police. Positive feedback has been received from the residents with regards to the new bus service.
5. **Chairman's Report:** Cllr Gray read the report to the members of the meeting.
6. **Stainton Village Hall Trust: Election of 1 Parishioner Representatives:** Cllr I Watkins proposed Cllr Fisher and Cllr Brown seconded the proposal.
7. **To consider any other relevant business:** Cllr K Watkins expressed thanks to Cllr Gray for his work carried out for the benefit of the village throughout the year; Cllr I Watkins seconded the expression of thanks.
