MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 18th October 2021

Public Session: Including the Village Hall Trust Update:

A member of the public wanted to bring to the Council's attention the state of the pavement on Stainton Lane. The debris from the road and vehicles from the quarry is slowly eroding the depth of pavement. The resident felt that the narrowing of the pavement made it dangerous for it to be used. Clerk to raise the matter with DMBC. The resident also pointed out that all the gullies were blocked along the extent of the road. Clerk to action.

Update from the Village Hall Trust

- The new decking has received its first coat of stain, weather permitting the second will soon be completed.
- The Village Hall is again fully open for hire. A number of new bookings have come in including repeat bookings.
- The village rounders/fun day was a great success in September. About 60 people of all ages and abilities attended the day. It was a great opportunity to speak to families that are new to the village and catch up with old friends. There were a number of rounders' matches on the field and refreshments and tombola in the hall. Funding was secured from DMBC Public Health to support this. In the spring we will be having regular rounders' matches on the recreational field. Thank you to everyone who volunteered and made this a great event. This will become an annual fun day.

109/2021 Ward Councillor Report

Ward Cllr Greenhalgh notified Council that he had found a commercial decorator who will assess the phone box and quote on the work necessary to bring it back to its former standard. Ward Cllr Greenhalgh notified Council that Wadworth Parish Council are having an afternoon of celebration on the 27th October to launch the newly refurbished Maypole, funded by Doncaster Sheffield Airport. Ward Cllr Greenhalgh spoke of a recent significant police presence in Tickhill where over 50 officers were operating with their main focus on speeding and anti-social driving. Ward Cllr Greenhalgh again spoke of the Wilsic Lane encampment which DMBC are investigating. Retrospective planning on the site has been applied for. Ward Cllr Greenhalgh concluded with Braithwell with Micklebring Parish Council's problems with articulated vehicles ignoring the weight restrictions throughout both villages, mostly involving Ashton Lane.

110/2021 Planning Applications.

21/02817/FUL – Land adjacent to Cliffe House. Holme Hall Lane, Stainton. S66 7RD

Erection of detached house with attached garage on approx. 0.04ha of land (being a resubmission of previously approved application 18/01828/FUL)

Council raised multiple concerns about this application. Visibility on the Holme Hall Road is already extremely difficult, and another dwelling with multiple cars will impact on this further. Where the proposed dwelling is located offers a pull in point for passing vehicles. If this is jeopardised passing in this area will be impossible, like it is for most of Holme Lane. Clerk to make representations to DMBC.

Council also discussed the state of the pond and the fact that the current treatment of the Iris pernicious does not seem to be resolving the problem. Cllr Brown suggested contacting Jones Homes (developer of the Grange Lane build) to ask for financial support to improve the pond and surrounding area. Cllr Brown to follow up.
